



SUBJECT : 2015 Training-Workshop on Contextualizing the Curriculum for Indigenous Peoples Education (IPED)

DATE : August 17, 2015

1. This refers to the conduct of the 2015 Training-Workshops on Contextualizing the Curriculum for Indigenous Peoples Education (Batches 1, 2, 3, and 4) with the following schedule:

2. The Enhanced Basic Education Program, as stipulated in Republic Act No. 10533 and the IPED provision of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Sec. 8.4), mandates DepEd to develop a curriculum that is culture-sensitive,

contextualized, and flexible enough to enable and allow schools to localize, indigenize, and enhance based on the specific educational and social context of communities.

3. In support of this mandate, the subject training-workshop aims to build the capacity of the Regional and Division Offices in indigenizing the basic education curriculum in partnership with indigenous communities. The indigenized curriculum will be the basis for developing indigenized lesson plans which will serve as a key reference of teachers in facilitating a culture-based and culture-responsive teaching-learning process.
4. At the end of the training-workshop, participants are expected to develop a holistic perspective on the overall learning and socio-cultural context of indigenous communities. In particular, participants are expected to:
 - a) gain and develop the competencies needed in contextualizing the curriculum responsive to the indigenous community being served;
 - b) gain and develop the competencies needed in developing lesson plans based on the contextualized curriculum for IPED;
 - c) formulate a work plan for the training of a regional core group for curriculum contextualization for IPED and production of lesson plans; and
 - d) form part of the regional pool of trainers.
5. The participants per region should be composed of the following:

 - b) Regional IPED Focal Person (1)


 - c) Chief, Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) (1)
 - d) Division IPED Focal Person (1)

6. The participants are requested to observe the following specific instructions:
 - For **Batch 1:** Accommodation starts at 2:00 pm on September 13, 2015 (Sunday) – first meal will be dinner of the same day; last meal is dinner of September 19, 2015 (Saturday)
 - For **Batch 2:** Accommodation starts at 2:00 pm on September 20, 2015 (Sunday) – first meal will be dinner of the same day; last meal is dinner of September 26, 2015 (Saturday)
