REGIONAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY FAIR FOR SY 2012-2013

To : Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. Pursuant to DepED Memorandum No. 149, s. 2012, the Secondary Education Division, this Office, will hold the Regional Science and Technology Fair for SY 2012-2013 on October 6-7, 2012 at the DepED Regional Office - RELC and DepED Conference Hall, Carig Sur, Tuguegarao City.
2. The objective of the search is to promote science and technology consciousness among the youth; and identify the most creative and the best student researchers who can ably represent the region in the national level competition.
3. Participants are the first place division level winners of both fair divisions in all fair categories whose entries have been approved by the regional level Scientific Review Committee (SRC), research advisers and Supervisors in Science and Mathematics.
4. The Science & Technology Fair Guidelines attached to DepED Memorandum No. 149, s. 2012 downloadable at <http://www.deped.gov.ph> will be used in the conduct of the said affair. Further, Division Science and Mathematics supervisors, School heads and Participants are expected to download softcopies of the International Rules for Pre-college Science Research: Guidelines for Science and Engineering Fair 2012-2013 and required forms from <http://www.societyforscience.org/isef/rulesand guidelines> for their guidance.
5. Submission of project manuscripts in four (4) copies per project entry to the Secondary Education Division, DepED Regional Office, Carig Sur, Tuguegarao City will be on or before September 28, 2012.
6. A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (P 4,000.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for six (6) meals (dinner for the SRC and Board of Judges) while, two (2) breakfast, two (2) lunches, and one (1) dinner and four (4) snacks (two (2) morning and two (2) afternoon for the members of the SRC and Board of Judges, education program supervisors, SED staff and other support staff, honoraria of the board of judges and cash prizes of first three student winners and advisers and the materials needed to the conduct of the Science Fair, while lodging conference halls, lights, sounds and other facilities shall be borne by DepED Regional Office. Travel expenses and registration fee of the participants will be charged against local/school funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations, while private school participants will charge their expenses against their school funds.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
