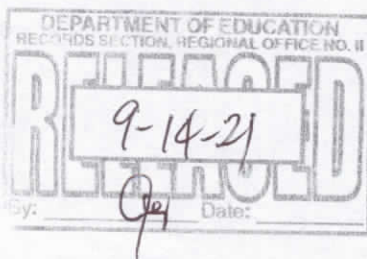
**CONDUCT OF WEBINAR ON “AGRI? AGREE! A CARREER ORIENTATION AND

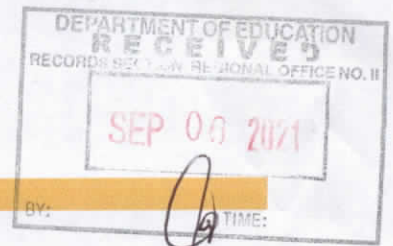


