The Department of Education through the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) will conduct the **Orientation of CLMD Chiefs, Regional Supervisors, Division Supervisors, and Focal Persons on the Preventive Drug Education Program Policy and Curriculum Model on July 26, 2022, via online platform.** This is in support of the National Drug Education Program (NDEP) as mandated in RA 9165 or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002 wherein the Department is decreed to effectively deliver the goals of the PDEP policy to our learners through the integration of the core standards in the school curricula.

The activity aims to: (1) present programs and projects of partners in support of the NDEP; (2) orient participants on the PDEP policy and curriculum model; and (3) determine initiatives (preliminary or ongoing) of the field implementers to support the PDEP.
