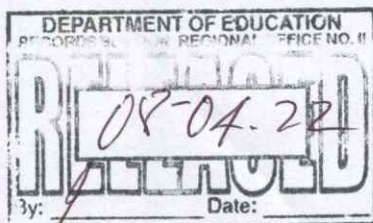

1. The ASEAN dance presentation is a showcase of the Native Folk Dance of the ASEAN Countries.
2. The members of the group may be composed of a minimum of 3 pairs and a maximum of 5 pairs to be participated in by the DepEd teaching and non-teaching.
3. Time allotment is a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes of performance including entrance and exit.
4. The ASEAN Dance Presentation division entry shall be sent to <https://bit.ly/3PMf16h> on or before August 22, 2022 with the subject "ASEAN Dance Presentation [SDO]."
